### Day Four

Read John 6:60-69

1. In Luke 4:34, the demon calls Jesus “The Holy One of GOD.” The only other time that title was used in the New Testament is John 6:69. What do you take from what Peter says in these verses?
2. What does it mean that Jesus’ Words “are spirit and they are life?” (verse 63)
3. Is GOD’s Word “Life” to you?

### Day Five

Read 1 John 4:1-6

1. What is the “spirit of the antichrist?”
2. What is the promise of verse 4?
3. What battles are you facing? Are you finding victory in them through the One who is with you?

## He’s Amazing!

Luke 4:31-44

### A. Be Amazed By Jesus.

#### 1. He amazed people with His Teaching - He Spoke with Authority.

*“Then he went down to Capernaum, a town in Galilee, and on the Sabbath began to teach the people. They were amazed at his teaching, because his message had authority.”* Luke 4:31-32

*“When Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were amazed at his teaching, because he taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law.”* Matthew 7:28-29

#### 2. He is Recognized by Demons.

*“In the synagogue there was a man possessed by a demon, an evil spirit. He cried out at the top of his voice, ‘Ha! What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are-- the Holy One of God!’”* Luke 4:33-34

*“Moreover, demons came out of many people, shouting, ‘You are the Son of God!’ But he rebuked them and would not allow them to speak, because they knew he was the Christ.”* Luke 4:41

#### 3. He Engages and Defeats the demons by His Word.

*“‘Be quiet!’ Jesus said sternly. ‘Come out of him!’ Then the demon threw the man down before them all and came out without injuring him. All the people were amazed and said to each other, ‘What is this teaching? With authority and power he gives orders to evil spirits and they come out!’ And the news about him spread throughout the surrounding area.”* Luke 4:35-37

### Note The Bible’s Teaching on demons.

#### 1. Demons are Spiritual Beings who have rebelled against GOD.

*“And the angels who did not keep their positions of authority but abandoned their own home-- these he has kept in darkness, bound with everlasting chains for judgment on the great Day.”* Jude 6

#### 2. We are Engaged in a Spiritual Battle.

*“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.”* Ephes. 6:10-12

#### 3. Jesus has already Defeated Them.

*“But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you. Or again, how can anyone enter a strong man's house and carry off his possessions unless he first ties up the strong man? Then he can rob his house.”* Matthew 12:28-29

*“And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.”* Colossians 2:15

**B. Commit Yourself To This Amazing Savior.**

1. **Accept Jesus for who He is—The Holy One of GOD.**

*“Ha! What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are-- the Holy One of God!”* Luke 4:34

*“From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him. ‘You do not want to leave too, do you?’ Jesus asked the Twelve. Simon Peter answered him, ‘Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God.’”* John 6:66-69

2. **Take To Heart The Power of His Word.**

*“But he said, ‘I must preach the good news of the kingdom of God to the other towns also, because that is why I was sent.’”* Luke 4:43

*“I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.”* Romans 1:16

*“For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God’s sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.”* Hebrews 4:12-13

3. **Live in Victory Over Evil .**

*“You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.”* 1 John 4:4

**Day Two**

2. The demon called Jesus “The Holy One of GOD.” What’s the meaning and significance of this name to you?
3. Jesus defeated/cast out the demon. What did this say to the people who witnessed these events?
